TEST

SUBJECT: USE OF MAP & COMPASS

STAR: 3

CONDUCT. The test must take place outside over a pre-selected route. The aim is to test the senior cadet’s knowledge of more advanced map reading and to see whether he can apply it practically by day and night.

Assessment. The test will be carried out as follows.

By Day	Max	Pass
1. The senior cadet must find his position on the map and check it by resection.....	20	10
2. The senior cadet is then shown on a map a route of not less than three miles with six changes of direction is requested to follow this route correctly as an individual.	20	10
3. On the route, there will be testers, who will set practical problems on:		
Back Bearings.....	10*	5*
Relating the map to the ground.....	10*	5*

By Night

A cadet is not to undertake night navigation until he has demonstrated his ability to navigate by day and has undertaken night navigation practices accompanied by other cadets. He will be shown a route on a map of not less than one mile and two changes of direction. He is required to follow this correctly as an individual. Cadets to be checked at each change of direction.

4. The cadet must set the compass correctly for a night March and be checked.....	20	10
5. The cadet will be checked on being able to complete The course correctly.....	20	10
